3-DAY ACE PROGRAM

Purpose:

The EduCare Foundation's **ACE 3-Day Program** is a comprehensive student success, youth empowerment, and character-building program focusing on:

Character development – confidence building, positive decision-making & constructive choices

Personal management – personal responsibility & accountability

Emotional intelligence - managing anger, fear, rejection & peer pressure

Interpersonal skills - communication, conflict resolution & team building

The **ACE 3-Day Program** is designed to assist youth in creating more successful and constructive lives. Through their involvement, students:

- Experience greater self-worth and motivation
- Identify and enhance their unique talents
- Develop skills for decision making and problem-solving as it relates to both school and personal life
- Gain awareness in regarding mistakes as learning opportunities
- Recognize and reform negative attitudes that continually interfere with creating academic and personal success
- Learn teambuilding and conflict resolution skills as they develop the ability to use conflict in a positive rather than destructive way
- Develop greater empathy and understanding for others
- Bridge the gap between diverse groups

Format:

- Interactive three consecutive-day workshop for approximately 100 students**
- Within each workshop, the larger group is divided into “resource groups” (of 7-10 students and one adult) for structured teambuilding and experiential activities. There will be also whole group activities.

***Can be more or less depending upon venue and adult to student ratios*

Teachers' & Adults' Roles and Responsibilities:

- General Supervision - help prepare room & workshop sessions, supervise & assist with break, lunch, arriving & departing, and bus coverage, if applicable
- Resource Group Leaders - active, positive role modeling & coaching
- Active participation & involvement

Since 1987, EduCare's programs have been offered to more than 40,000 students in schools, school districts, and youth serving agencies worldwide. Its youth development programs, professional development trainings, and parent workshops have been widely cited as outstanding models for innovative and self-sustaining change.
